WHAT TO DROP



- Expired/Unwanted Prescription Meds
- Over-the-Counter Medications
- Medication Samples
- Pet Medications
- Liquid Medications
- Medicated Ointments
- Inhalers
- Vitamins

WHAT NOT TO DROP



- Needles/Lancets/Syringes
- Thermometers
- IV Bags
- Nebulizer Machines
- Diabetes Test Kits
- Oxygen Tanks
- Personal Care Products
(shampoo, lotion, etc.)

HOW TO DROP

Keep medications in their original containers.

DO NOT REMOVE medication name.

Cross off or remove your name.

Place liquid medication bottles in a plastic bag.
