

Town of Lebanon – Annual Meeting Minutes – April 21, 2015

7:30 pm Chairman Prochnow called the meeting to order.

Minutes from the 4/15/14 Annual Meeting were read aloud.

MOTION (Karen Kuehl, Jan Popke) to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried unanimously.

2014 Financial Report was read aloud.

MOTION (William Kuehl, Connie Laughlin) to approve the 2014 Financial Report as read. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION (William Kuehl, Jan Popke) to continue donating \$500 annually to each of the three cemeteries in the Town. Motion carried unanimously.

Waupaca County's Recycling Coordinator, Debbie Krogwold, was recognized. She shared the history of the County's recycling efforts as well as details on the newest 'pay by bag' program.

Chairman Prochnow reported that Madden, Worm, Obertin, Little Creek and Buelow roads were found to be in need of the Town's attention this year during the recent inspection.

The Board is currently seeking the best option to refinance the Hall's debt with the State's Trust Fund program. Once further information is gathered from a local lender, the Board will be able to compare for the best available rate.

Curbside recycling/garbage collection is still being considered as a service to our residents. More information will be shared when available.

Open Book is scheduled for May 8th, 3 pm to 5 pm. The Assessor will be present to address your questions or concerns regarding your property values.

Waupaca County Highway Department will be reconstructing North Shawano Street (County Road D), between Walmart and Hwy 45. Be advised this project is scheduled to begin in July.

The Town recently purchased another plow truck, and has hired additional drivers for our on-call needs throughout the winter season.

An informational meeting is tentatively scheduled for May 18th regarding the need for rezoning on properties currently within the Resource Protection Overlay. All affected landowners will be notified by letter of this meeting.

Board of Review is scheduled for June 1st, beginning at 5:00 pm. Please check the Town's website for further instructions and related forms.

The projected completion date of County Road T was discussed. All seeking further information are encouraged to contact Waupaca County Highway Commissioner, Dean Steingraber.
