## Pay-By-The-Bag Garbage Program



**Recycle More!**

**Pay Less for Garbage!**

**What is Pay-By-The-Bag?** Pay-By-The-Bag garbage programs enable you to pay only for the garbage you produce instead of paying a flat rate no matter how much you have. The beauty of this system is that the more you recycle and compost, the less garbage you have, and the less you have to pay for that garbage. **Pay-By-The-Bag saves you money!**

### How much can I save?

- The average cost for curbside pickup of garbage and recyclables in your area is \$72 per quarter, or \$24 per month.
- At the **Manawa Area Recycling Center**, the cost to dispose of a 35-gallon size bag of garbage is **ONLY \$2.50**. You pay nothing for the recyclables.
- If you have four 35-gallon size bags of garbage each month, the cost would be \$10. This amounts to a **savings of \$14 per month or \$168 per year**. If you have **less than** four 35-gallon size bags of garbage each month, your **savings would be more!**
- **The More You Recycle! The More You Save!**

### I want to recycle more and save money! Tell me how!

- **FIRST:** Separate all recyclables from your garbage. **See reverse side of this flyer for recycling guidelines.** There is no charge for recycling at the Center.
- **SECOND:** Place your garbage (after all recyclables are removed) into a **CLEAR bag (maximum size 35 gallon; maximum weight 30 lbs)**. CLEAR bags are available for purchase at most grocery and hardware stores.
- **THIRD:** Wrap a **blue Manawa Area Recycling Center garbage tag** around the neck of each **CLEAR garbage bag**. All garbage bags, no matter the size, must be tagged. Tags are available for purchase in sheets of 5 at \$12.50 per sheet from:

- **FOURTH:** Bring your tagged garbage bags along with your separated recyclables to:



## RECYCLING GUIDELINES

The items residents and businesses are required to recycle are listed below.

Following these guidelines will insure a marketable product and benefit your recycling program.

<p><b>TIN CANS</b>  <b>ALUMINUM CANS</b> </p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Separate tin cans from aluminum cans. Rinse.</li> <li>✓ Flatten if possible.</li> <li>✓ <b>NO</b> hangers, oil filters, or other metal.</li> </ul>
<p><b>NEW</b>  <b>PLASTIC BOTTLES &amp; CONTAINERS</b> (rinse, discard caps) </p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Soda, water, milk, juice bottles</li> <li>✓ Produce, bakery, deli containers (berry, donut, dips, salads, etc.)</li> <li>✓ Dairy containers &amp; lids (yogurt, margarine, cottage cheese, sour cream, etc.)</li> <li>✓ <b>NO</b> motor oil bottles, plastic bags, toys, laundry baskets, plastic utensils, plastic cups, Tupperware, or plant pots.</li> </ul>
<p><b>GLASS BOTTLES &amp; JARS</b> (Food and beverage ONLY) </p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Sort by color: CLEAR, BROWN, GREEN/BLUE</li> <li>✓ Rinse. Labels are OK! Discard caps and lids.</li> <li>✓ <b>NO</b> mugs, glassware, ceramics, windows, vases, cookware, light bulbs, or candle jars.</li> </ul>
<p><b>MIXED PAPER &amp; CARDBOARD</b> </p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper, egg cartons, catalogs, paperback books, shredded paper.</li> <li>✓ Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, other boxboard, corrugated cardboard</li> <li>✓ <b>Flatten cardboard to 3 ft. x 3 ft. size.</b></li> <li>✓ <b>NO</b> paper contaminated with food, paper napkins, cups, plates, milk or juice cartons.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>OTHER ITEMS:</u> No Charge</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Waste Oil</li> <li>✓ Vehicle Batteries</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>OTHER ITEMS:</u> Fee</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Oil Filters (\$0.25 each)</li> </ul>
