Open Burning & Recycling



Waupaca County Recycling Ordinance & Wisconsin Recycling Law

1. Regulations regarding Residential open burning:

- **Allows** for the burning of leaves, grass, brush, unpainted & untreated solid wood, and small amounts of confidential papers
- **Prohibits** the burning of recyclables, garbage, waste materials, and any other debris
- **Requires** compliance with all local laws, ordinances, and other regulations, including obtaining all applicable burning permits
- **Mandates** the recycling of cardboard, container board, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, plastic bottles/containers, steel cans, aluminum cans, glass bottles/jars, yard waste, motor oil, oil filters, vehicle batteries, tires, appliances, and electronics

2. Regulations regarding Business/Commercial open burning (including farming operations):

- **Prohibits** the burning of any item as a means of disposal, unless licensed by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for energy recovery
- **Mandates** the recycling of cardboard, container board, newspaper, magazines, office paper, plastic bottles/containers, steel cans, aluminum cans, glass bottles/jars, yard waste, motor oil, oil filters, vehicle batteries, tires, appliances, and electronics

- Accepts all recyclable items, including appliances and electronics (fees may apply)
- Accepts garbage, construction/demolition debris, and special waste items (fee)

4. 'Pay-per-Bag' Disposal Programs for Garbage

- **Clintonville Area Waste Service** (open to Clintonville, T. Larrabee, T. Matteson residents)
\$2.00 per 35-gal size clear bag of garbage; tag required; 27-pound maximum
- **Iola Area Recycling Center** (open to all County residents)
\$2.50 per 35-gal size clear bag of garbage; tag required; 30-pound maximum
- **Manawa Area Recycling Center** (open to all County residents)
\$2.50 per 35-gal size clear bag of garbage; tag required; 30-pound maximum
- **Waupaca Regional Recycling & Composting Center** (open to all County residents)
\$3.00 per 35-gal size clear bag of garbage; tag required; 30-pound maximum



RECYCLING PREPARATION GUIDELINES

- **Recycling Centers:** Separate RECYCLABLES as indicated in the Table below.
- **PTF:**
 - Aluminum cans/steel cans/plastic bottles & containers can be mixed together
 - Glass bottles and jars (clear bottles must be separated from brown & green bottles)
 - Paper and cardboard can be mixed together
- **Municipal Curbside:** Single-stream collection. Paper, cardboard, aluminum/steel cans, plastic bottles/containers, and glass bottles/jars can be all mixed together in one bin, **separate from garbage.**

ALUMINUM CANS 	✓ Rinse; flatten if possible
STEEL CANS 	✓ Rinse; flatten if possible
PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Rinse; remove and discard all screw caps ✓ Soda, water, milk, juice bottles ✓ Produce, bakery, deli containers (berry, donut, dips, potato salad) ✓ Dairy containers & lids (yogurt, cottage cheese, sour cream, etc.) ✓ NO motor oil bottles, plastic bags, toys, laundry baskets, plastic utensils, plastic cups, or Tupperware
GLASS BOTTLES & JARS (Food and beverage ONLY) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Rinse; remove and discard all caps and lids ✓ Sort by color (clear, brown, green) if using Recycling Centers ✓ NO cups, ceramics, windows, vases, cookware, or light bulbs
NEWSPAPERS, MIXED PAPER, CARDBOARD 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Newspaper, colored inserts, magazines, junk mail, shredded paper ✓ Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons, cardboard, phonebooks ✓ Flatten cardboard to 3 ft. x 3 ft. size ✓ NO paper contaminated with food, paper napkins, cups, plates, milk or juice cartons
MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, VEHICLE BATTS	✓ Waupaca, Manawa, Marion, Clintonville, PTF (fees may apply)
LEAVES, GRASS, BRUSH	✓ Waupaca, Marion, Clintonville, PTF (fees may apply)
TIRES	✓ Waupaca, Clintonville, PTF (fees apply)
OTHER ITEMS: Appliances, Computers, TVs, Electronics, Fluorescents, Oil-Spill Absorbents, Garbage, Construction/Demolition Debris, Antifreeze, Hazardous Waste (by appt.)	ACCEPTED AT: Waupaca County PTF E4981 Swan Rd., Manawa WI 715-258-6249 (fees may apply)
